McDaniel College is an accredited, private selective College of the Liberal Arts and Sciences, located in Westminster, Maryland, U.S.A., where students from 21 countries prepare for lives of leadership and service. The European Campus of McDaniel College in Budapest is accredited by the Commission on Higher Education of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools. McDaniel College Budapest is registered in Hungary as a foreign institution of higher education by the permission of the Hungarian Minister of Education. It offers **a standard American four-year undergraduate program in Hungary**, leading to a Bachelor of Arts degree.

A unique feature of the program is that students have the option to complete the upper two years of **study at the main campus of the college in the United States**. In addition, students enrolled at Budapest earn credits that are fully transferable to any other American college or university with the provision that they are based on grades of at least "C" or higher.

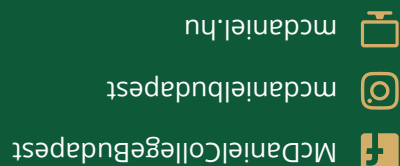
- Central location (VII district of Budapest).

FLEXIBLE PROGRAM

McDaniel College is flexible: you can enter our program as undecided, sample a number of different courses, and then choose your major based on what you prefer. In addition, if you decide you would like to pursue a major different than the one you started, you can change majors—all of the credits you have earned remain on your record, and no time is lost for graduation.

DUAL MAJOR

Some of our majors can be pursued in combined dual major programs—art-communication, business-economics—that combine the best features of more than one major program in order to give students more options after graduation.

DESCRIPTION

The Psychology major involves coursework that explores behavior, emotions, cognitive processes and the factors that influence them from a variety of perspectives.

Psychology is a pluralistic discipline with roots in and connections to the natural sciences, the social sciences, medicine and the humanities, and the McDaniel Europe program gives students training in these various roots, providing rigorous theoretical and practical training necessary for a career as a psychologist in medicine, business, and education, as well as preparation for graduate-level work. Psychology students work closely with faculty and other students on research projects, developing their own, individualized research projects in their final year. This work is enhanced with internship opportunities putting students in different, challenging organizational environments in which their growing knowledge of psychology is essential.

SOME OF OUR COURSES

HEALTH PSYCHOLOGY

/An introduction to the foundation and practice of health psychology. A bio-psycho-social perspective is applied to the promotion and maintenance of health and the prevention and treatment of illness. Behavioral components of health risk factors and improvement of the health care system are addressed./

SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGY

/This course will introduce students to research and theory in social psychology which involves the study of how other people (real, imagined, or implied) influence our thoughts, feelings, and behavior. This course will include discussion of research in the areas of the self, social cognition, conformity, persuasion, group behavior, stereotyping and prejudice, attraction, aggression, prosocial behavior, and gender and culture./

COGNITIVE PSYCHOLOGY

/This course will introduce students to theory and research in cognitive psychology: how the human brain and mind give rise to our perceptions, thoughts, and feelings. Topics discussed: will include perception, attention, memory, language, emotion, reasoning and judgment, conscious and unconscious mental processing and cognitive models./

COUNSELING PSYCHOLOGY

/A careful overview of major approaches involving cognitive, behavioral, psychodynamic and humanistic theories. Students evaluate theories and apply them to clinical cases./
