General Guidelines on Campus

• At present, masks are not required **but highly recommended** in the spaces of the campus. However, those in the building are urged to practice social distancing and bear in mind proper hygiene such as frequent hand washing whenever possible. The McDaniel administration reserves the right to change masking and other policies in the event that the Covid situation in Budapest, Hungary, and the region should itself change.

What To Do If You Test Positive For Covid

- In case you feel sick, please stay home. If you test positive for Covid-19, you should self-isolate. You should do so seven days before you return to campus.
- If you are self-isolating, then a peer mentor will keep in touch with you. They will be in contact with you while you are recovering and make sure that you are not having any undue difficulties keeping up with your coursework.
